ECONOMICS MAJOR, B.A. – 2020-2021

In order to qualify for admission into the Economics major, students must complete Economics 1, 2, and 10A with a UC grade-point average of **2.85** or above. No grade lower than a C in pre-major courses will be accepted. In addition, students must complete PSTAT 109 or 120A and Math 2A-B, 3A-B, or 34A-B with a grade of "C" or higher; the grades in these courses will not be used in computing the pre-major GPA but will apply to the overall major GPA.
